**SUMMARY:** There is more than 85% chance of receiving over 75 mm of rainfall over much of Zambia.




Figure 1: Forecasted total rainfall for the period 16<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> Dec, 2025

## PERIOD: 16<sup>TH</sup> TO 19<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2025

WESTERN, NORTHWESTERN, SOUTHERN, LUSAKA AND COPPERBELT PROVINCES INCLUDING THE WESTERN DISTRICTS OF CENTRAL PROVINCE:

**MORNINGS:** Mainly cloudy with outbreaks of rainfall and occasional thunder. Minimum temperature will be mild to warm ranging from 13°C to 21°C.

**AFTERNOONS:** Mostly cloudy with rainfall and thunder. Maximum temperature will be warm to hot ranging from 23°C to 32°C.

**NIGHTS:** Mainly cloudy with rainfall and occasional thunder.

LUAPULA, NORTHERN, MUCHINGA AND EASTERN PROVINCES INCLUDING THE EASTERN DISTRICTS OF CENTRAL PROVINCE:

**MORNINGS:** Mainly cloudy with a chance of rainfall and occasional thunder. Minimum temperature will be mild to warm ranging from 13°C to 21°C.

**AFTERNOONS:** Mostly cloudy with isolated showers and thunderstorms. Maximum temperature will be warm to hot ranging from 24°C to 33°C.

**NIGHTS:** Mainly cloudy with a chance of rainfall and occasional thunder.

PERIOD: 20<sup>TH</sup> TO 22<sup>ND</sup> DECEMBER, 2025

**THE WHOLE COUNTRY**. Mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain and thunder. It will be mild to warm with maximum temperature ranging from 23°C to 32°C

**ADVISORY:** Farmers are advised to continue with weeding, regularly inspect fields for waterlogging and monitor crops for pests and diseases. Planting and replanting activities should also continue where necessary.

The general public is advised to avoid taking shelter under trees and to refrain from parking vehicles or leaving valuable property beneath trees due to expected storm activity.
