

ZAMBIA EVENING WEATHER FORECAST: TUESDAY (13/01/2026)

SUMMARY:

The Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is still oscillating about southern Zambia, leading to rainfall over most parts of the country.

FORECAST FOR TONIGHT TUESDAY (13/01/2026)

Western, Southern, Lusaka, Northwestern, Copperbelt and Luapula Provinces including the western parts of Central province:

Mostly cloudy, slightly windy and mild with rain and occasional thunder.

Northern, Muchinga and Eastern Provinces including the eastern parts of Central province:

Mainly cloudy, windy at times and mild with isolated rain and occasional thunder.

FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: WEDNESDAY (14/01/2026)

Western, Southern, Lusaka, Luapula, Northwestern and Copperbelt Provinces including the western parts of Central province:

Morning: Mostly cloudy, windy at times and mild with rain and occasional thunder. Minimum temperature will be ranging between 14°C and 22°C.

Afternoon: Mainly cloudy, slightly windy and warm with rain and thunderstorms. Maximum temperature will be ranging between 25°C and 31°C.

Evening: Mostly cloudy, windy at times and mild with isolated rain and occasional thunder.

Northern, Muchinga and Eastern Provinces including the eastern parts of Central province:

Morning: Mainly cloudy and mild to warm with isolated rain and occasional thunder. Minimum temperature will be ranging between 11°C and 22°C.

Afternoon: Mainly cloudy, slightly windy and warm to hot with isolated showers and thunderstorms. Maximum temperature will be ranging between 26°C and 33°C.

Evening: Mostly cloudy, windy at times with isolated rain and thunderstorms.

OUTLOOK TO THURSDAY (15/01/2026)

Mainly cloudy with rainfall are expected across most parts of the country.
