



SEVEN DAYS WEATHER FORECAST: 23rd - 29th January, 2018

GENERAL SITUATION

From 23rd to 28th January, 2018, Moist and unstable airflow from the North West will be affecting the northern half of Zambia leaving the southern half under the influence of moist but stable winds from the southeast. By 29th January, 2018 moist and unstable winds from the North West will start affecting most parts of the country.

FORECAST FOR THE PERIOD: 23rd to 28th January, 2018

Eastern, Lusaka, Central and Southern Provinces: Partly cloudy and warm in the morning becoming hot with a chance of afternoon showers and thunderstorms.

The rest of Zambia: Cloudy and mild with a chance of morning rain, becoming warm to hot with afternoon showers and thunderstorms in places.

The nights will be mainly clear except for North western, Copperbelt, Luapula, Northern and Muchinga Provinces which will be cloudy with a chance of rain and thunder.

FORECAST FOR 29th January, 2018

Most Areas of Zambia: Cloudy with morning rains, afternoon showers and thunderstorms, heavy falls expected over Eastern, Muchinga and eastern districts of Central Provinces.

The nights will be partly cloudy to cloudy with rain and thunder in few places.
