Seven days Weather Forecast

6th – 13th March, 2017

GENERAL SITUATION

The Inter tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) will be oscillating about the central and southern parts of Zambia and continue inducing moist and unstable airflow over much of the Country on the 6th and 7th March, 2017. From the 8th to 11th march, 2017 the high pressure system cited over South Africa will strengthen and push the ITCZ northwards and start inducing cool and moist south-easterly airflow over much of the southern half, reducing rainfall activities and the day time temperature.

The period from 12th and 13th March, 2017 a continental high pressure system will start controlling the weather over much of Zambia increasing the daytime temperature. However, moist and unstable airflow in the upper levels of the atmosphere will increase afternoon thundershowers over much of Zambia.

Forecast for the period 6th & 7th March, 2017

Luapula, Northern and Muchinga Provinces: Partly cloudy to cloudy with morning rain, afternoon showers and thunderstorms in few places.

The Rest of Zambia: Cloudy with morning rain, afternoon thundershowers in places.

Forecast for the Period 8th to 11th March, 2017

Southern, Lusaka, Central and Eastern Provinces: Partly cloudy to cloudy, windy and cool with morning light rain, afternoon thundershowers in few places.

The Rest of Zambia: Mainly cloudy with morning rain, afternoon thundershowers in places.

Forecast for the Period 8th to 11th March, 2017

Luapula, Northern, Muchinga and Eastern Provinces: Partly cloudy to cloudy, slightly windy with a chance of morning rain, afternoon thundershowers in few places.

The Rest of Zambia: Partly cloudy, slightly windy and warm, becoming cloudy with a chance of morning light rain, afternoon showers and thunderstorms in places.
