Weather Overview

A high-pressure system over the Indian Ocean is currently driving strong, moist, and cool airflow across Zambia. The system is expected to remain active throughout the forecast period, resulting in windy conditions across the country. A reduction in temperature is expected over Western, Lusaka, Central, Southern, Eastern and Muchinga provinces.

ADVISORY

The general public is here advised to take the precaution measures:

- Dress warmly, especially during the cooler night and early morning hours.
- Individuals with respiratory conditions, the elderly and children are encouraged to limit exposure to dust and use appropriate protective measures where necessary.
- Parents and guardians are advised to closely supervise children and ensure they are kept safe from open fires, braziers, and other heating sources to avoid unnecessary burn injuries during the cold weather
- Users of water transport are advised to exercise extreme caution when operating on water bodies due to hazardous windy conditions.

The Zambia Meteorological Department, in the Ministry of Green Economy and Environment, will keep monitoring weather patterns and share timely updates with the public, alongside the Disaster Risk Management Division (DRMD). Stay alert and updated with daily weather updates
